# Graduate Diploma of Strategic Leadership

## Entry Requirements

- Must be 23 years or above on commencement

### Academic Requirements: (Applicants Only Need to Satisfy One Point)

- Students **MUST** have completed a graduate certificate in management (e.g. BSB80515) or a bachelor's degree in business, management or related domains or candidates are undertaking this course as a pathway to a master's degree with a higher education provider-packaged course
- Have completed a Diploma or Advanced Diploma qualification in related fields of study and 3 years equivalent of full-time relevant workplace experience at a significant level of leadership and management responsibility and/or complexity in an enterprise
- Have completed a bachelor's degree in related fields of study and 2 years equivalent of full-time relevant workplace experience at a significant level of leadership and management responsibility and/or complexity in an enterprise
- Have five years equivalent of full-time relevant workplace experience at a significant level of leadership and management responsibility and/or complexity in an enterprise

### English Language (International Students):

- IELTS 6.0 or higher with a minimum score of 5.5 in each band OR
- Equivalent English level scores (e.g. PTE, TOEFL, EAP, CE etc.)
